Full-time Students

£1,000 bursaries available for most full-time students.

If you are on an eligible programme, the College will give you up to a maximum of £1,000 each year of your studies. You will receive the bursary whatever the level of your family income. All eligible full-time students can apply for a Tuition Fee Loan, Maintenance Loan and Maintenance Grant. You can download a form from www.direct.gov.uk/studentfinance. Help may also be available from the College's Access Fund.

Part-time Students

Financial help is available. You may be able to receive a Tuition Fee Grant towards the costs of your fees and a Course Grant to help with other costs. Both are non-repayable. You can download a form from www.direct.gov.uk/studentfinance. Special bursaries are applicable to some programmes. Help may also be available from the College's Access Fund. Part-time Further Education courses (including courses prefixed SFA - funded by the Skills Funding Agency)

- Aged under 19 on 31st August 2010 - no fees
- In receipt of income based benefit - no fees subject to satisfying the eligibility criteria (evidence must be provided at the time of enrolment).
- GCSE Maths and English - no fees
- Adults who enrol on their first full Level 2 course - no fees. This means that you do not hold a qualification at this level (the equivalent of 5 GCSE's at Grade C or above). You will need to sign a declaration at enrolment.
- Adults under 25 who enrol on their first full Level 3 course - no fees. This means that you do not hold a qualification at this level (equivalent of 2 A-Levels). You will need to sign a declaration at enrolment.

Full-time Higher Education programmes

Fees are payable either through a Tuition Fee Loan - visit www.direct.gov.uk/studentfinance - or at the beginning of the course. There is an option to pay in three termly instalments which are due at the beginning of each term.

- No refunds apply unless the College cancels the course.

Payment terms

If you are aged 19+ on 31st August 2010 and are paying your fees yourself, the College offers an instalment plan for fees over £200. Please contact us for details. All fees up to £200 are payable at enrolment, unless your fees are being paid for you by a sponsor or your employer. You must present a letter from your sponsor/employer at enrolment. You must pay by Visa, Switch, Mastercard, cheque or cash. All prices include tuition and awarding body registration and certificate fees where applicable.
