

Professional qualifications for employers

Part-time Higher Education

A foundation degree is equivalent to the first two years of a full honours programme. A student studying on our part-time degrees can complete the foundation degree in two years, with a further year study available to top-up to a Bachelor qualification.

FdA Business & Management

A recently re-developed degree focused to the current needs of business. Students will gain the knowledge, understanding and skills to drive forward business strategy.



FdSc Applied Business Computing

Aimed at those who want to grow their skills and knowledge of computer systems to develop and support web-based and commercial systems in all types of businesses to an advanced level.



FdSc Computing with Networking

Developed to support the explosive growth in communications and the need for IT professionals who can not only specify, design and implement network infrastructure but also implement, manage, support and troubleshoot web based applications. This programme incorporates the Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) syllabus, which is recognised by employers worldwide.



FdA Retailing

This programme will give students an understanding of the key concepts appropriate for modern retailing, combining general principles of business and management with specialist retailing modules.

Funding your training

In challenging times, we understand that training budgets are limited. Students studying full and part-time higher education programmes are able to apply for financial assistance from Student Finance England. Fees are not paid back until after the course is completed and repayments only start once the student is earning over £21,000 per year.
