#### **New initiatives**

New College Durham has been awarded the licence to operate as the North East Institute of Technology, one of 12 established Institutes of Technology in the country.

As an IoT, we specialise in delivering higher technical education with a focus on STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) subjects such as engineering, digital and construction. Learning takes place in our new North East Institute of Technology centre and focuses on the specific technical skills required to provide employers with the skilled workforce they need.

We work in collaboration with our partners to design and deliver top quality courses and qualifications that meet the needs of industry in our region, both now and in the future. The IoT will give students the chance to improve existing skills or develop new ones to progress their careers and increase their employment opportunities.

Technology in the construction industry is moving at a rapid pace. We are constantly updating our resources and facilities so our students can experience the latest innovations.

The newest addition to the North Fast Institute of Technology is a virtual reality design suite. The Business Information Modelling/Virtual Reality Design Suite was designed to support digital construction industry needs covering building information modelling (BIM) with 3D model creation to simulate reallife scenarios. The facilities also allow the integration of virtual reality (VR) from concept designs, enabling students to engage in a one-to-one scale walk through model. The VR Active Wall studio is a full-scale immersive experience for groups to work together with the 3D model/design.

The IoT suite is also equipped with three robotic cells which feature Mitsubishi 6-axis bench size robotic arms. Each cell can be controlled by a hand-held teach pendant or by a laptop with Mitsubishi RT3 robotic simulation software. Students are taught how to use both methods of control and to develop robotic programs to carry out similar tasks required by maintenance technicians within industry.

#### ■ Higher National Certificate/Diploma (HNC/HND)

These are work-related, practical qualifications that give you skills you can use in a particular job. They can help you enter your chosen career or progress in your current role.

#### Foundation degrees

A foundation degree offers a combination of technical skills and academic study. It is a qualification in its own right or can be topped up to an honours degree.

#### Honours degrees

Degrees give you a thorough understanding of one or more subjects. They help you develop your analytical, intellectual and writing skills. You can use your degree to move into employment or you could go on to a postgraduate course.

#### ■ Top-up degree

This study programme allows you to convert your foundation degree or HND into a full honours degree.

#### Master's degree

A master's degree is undertaken by degree graduates and covers a precise area of study.

#### Degree & higher apprenticeships

These apprenticeships give you the chance to gain practical work experience and study a university level qualification.

#### Professional qualifications

Professional qualifications are vocational training courses that relate to a specific industry or career path. They are designed to ensure that everyone employed in a particular job meets the minimum required standards of professional expertise.
