This year's graduation ceremony will take place at **Ramside Hall Hotel** on **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2026**.

Eligibility is based on whether you have completed and passed your course once the July 2026 boards have completed. If you have any outstanding assessments due or are awaiting results at the date of graduation, please contact our team via email to confirm your eligibility to graduate.

*(Please note – this eligibility is subject to change depending on the outcome of the July 2026 board).*

You will receive an invite from us prior to the boards if you are due to complete any of the following qualification types:

- » Foundation Degree (FdA/FdSc)
- » Top-up Degree
- » Full honours degree
- » HNC
- » HND
- » Higher and Masters Apprenticeships
- » Professional Qualifications (Level 4 to Level 7)

# Registration

We need to know well in advance how many people are going to attend. The registration form asks important questions for which we require a response, to enable us to successfully plan the ceremony.

## **IMPORTANT**

### **Your contact information**

Please ensure you carefully check your inbox and spam/junk folders for any emails from our team. It is crucial that the contact details that we have stored for you are fully up to date. You can check and update contact information by emailing [graduation@newdur.ac.uk](mailto:graduation@newdur.ac.uk)

For those studying an apprenticeship, you will be invited to graduate from your main qualification, and you don't need to have completed your end point assessment.

Registration links will be sent via email and WhatsApp. If you haven't received an invitation, please thoroughly check your spam/junk folders before contacting us on [graduation@newdur.ac.uk](mailto:graduation@newdur.ac.uk) so we can investigate.

**All registrations must be completed before by the set deadline (TBC).**

### **What if I have registered but find out I haven't passed my course?**

Your graduation invitation is subject to the Assessment Board confirming you have successfully passed your course. If you have been unsuccessful and you need to resit, you will not be eligible to graduate this time. A refund will be issued for tickets purchased.

# Location

## Where does the ceremony take place?

**Ramside Hall Hotel, Carrville, Durham DH1 1TD**

A few weeks after you have registered, you will be sent an email telling you your ceremony time and giving you details of what you need to do next.

The ceremony will last for approximately one hour.



# Dress code

## Gowns

It is compulsory that all students who are taking part in the graduation ceremony wear an official gown. Gowns must be hired from the college's recommended gown hire company to ensure the correct colour and style for your course is ordered.

Your graduation is a formal occasion, and appropriate dress and behaviour is expected. Graduates and guests should wear smart clothes.

Our gowning company recommends that men wear a shirt and tie, and women wear a top with buttons (or a brooch) as it is easier to secure your hood by looping it around a button/brooch.





After you have registered, you will be sent details of gown hire costs and how to hire your gown. There are various packages/ bundles available for purchase which will be communicated to you directly from the gowning company.

Your gown will be available to collect the day of your ceremony from Ramside Hall. If you have ordered your gown online, please bring your email payment confirmation with you on the day.

Please note, you cannot leave Ramside Hall with your gown and must return it to the gowning area as promptly as possible after your ceremony and reception.

# Memories

## Photography & Livestream

If you have family or friends who are unable to attend the ceremonies, they will be able to watch a livestream of the occasion. A link will be sent closer to the day. There will also be college photographers and videographers, as well as external photography companies, present at the event. New College Durham will use images for marketing purposes. If you wish to be excluded from any pictures or videos for marketing purposes, please let a member of the media teams aware on the day.

### How do I pre-order my photographs?

A professional photographer will be available on the day at Ramside Hall. Once you have registered you will be sent a link to confirm your photography and gown package. The arrangements for photography will be dealt with, and communicated to you, directly from William Northam – the company we use for photography and gowning.

Guests may take photographs during the ceremony, but must remain in their seats. We also ask graduands and their guests to consider others when taking photographs. Following the ceremony, guests and graduates are welcome to take photos.

## Guests

Guest tickets will be available to purchase via our online booking system once they are available and you will receive updates regarding purchasing guest tickets following your registration for the event.

Graduates registering before the closing date will receive an email when the tickets are available to purchase. This email will also detail the number of tickets available to purchase per graduate.

You will be notified of the availability of tickets via email and text message/WhatsApp.

### Guest Seating Arrangements

Guests are seated in the guest section behind the students and academic staff. They enter via a different route to the graduands (those about to graduate) and are escorted into the room. Guests take their seats approximately 20 minutes before the ceremony (some areas of seating may be reserved for visitors with specific accessibility needs and will be signposted as such).

We aim to make our graduation ceremonies as welcoming as possible, but the formal nature and duration of the ceremonies may make them unsuitable for babies and small children. Any child over two years old should have his/her own seat and therefore require a fully priced ticket.

Children under the age of 2 without their own ticket must be seated on an adult's knee in your guest party. Pushchairs/prams/baby car seats may

be required to be left outside the event venue for health and safety reasons.

### IMPORTANT

**All guests must have a purchased ticket. If any guest is found to not have a ticket, access will be denied due to health and safety. Tickets will be checked at multiple points throughout the event.**

**Guest tickets allocation will be limited per graduate. Once the initial sale period has ended, we will review any remaining capacity for further guest tickets to be released should any be available.**

**Please note students who are graduating do not need a ticket for themselves.**

On the day, guests need to arrive for your ceremony with their tickets readily available to scan, either printed or on a mobile device. Guests will not be permitted to enter without a valid ticket. Please note, refunds for guest tickets will only be given to those who failed to successfully complete their course.

### What if I want to defer my graduation?

Deferrals to future ceremonies are only permitted for those who need to re-sit or due to extenuating personal circumstances. For consideration of deferral, please contact [graduation@newdur.ac.uk](mailto:graduation@newdur.ac.uk)

Please note, you must apply for a deferral before the date of your ceremony and attend the next available graduation event.

# On the Day

## What time do I need to arrive?

Please arrive an hour and a half before the start of your ceremony time. It is essential that you check in on arrival. Please ensure you plan ahead, giving ample time for any potential delays such as traffic or weather conditions.

## What do my guests do when they arrive?

Your guests may arrive with you, or later. All guests must arrive and check in at least 20 minutes prior to the ceremony time. The guests will wait in the reception area where refreshments can be purchased before the ceremony begins. **Please note: there is limited seating within the reception area.**

Please ensure your guests arrive with their ticket, either printed or via their mobile. If any guest is found to not have a ticket, access will be denied due to health and safety. Tickets will be checked throughout the event.

## What will happen before my ceremony?

Once you have checked in, you will go to the gowning area to collect your gown. After gowning, you will head to the meeting area to line up for the student procession. Your guests will already be seated in the hall. At time of ceremony, the VIP party followed by staff procession enter the hall.

Please note: as there is no cloakroom or holding area, we advise keeping personal belongings to a minimum.

Once they are seated, the student procession will enter the hall in a specific order, led by your Head of School where you will be shown to your seat. You must stay in the order you are given, as that is the order you will be called up to the stage.

## During the ceremony

The VIP party will proceed to the stage and deliver welcoming speeches.

Once ready the Chair of the ceremony will invite the principal guest to undertake the presentation of degrees and diplomas.

You will be directed to stand up one row at a time by attending staff and you will line up ready to go up onto the stage. When your name is announced, you will walk slowly onto the stage and meet the principal guest who will shake your hand and present you with your scroll. You will pause at this point while a photographer takes a photo of you receiving your scroll (you will be emailed information about purchasing this photo).

After this, you will continue to walk over to the other side of the stage and then return to your seat. Students selected for the vote of thanks will be contacted closer to the time with more information and guidance.

On completion of the ceremony, the VIP party will leave, followed by graduates and guests. There will be a reception in the main ballroom, which you and your ticketed guests are welcome to attend.

Refreshments will be available to purchase throughout the day, though these are not permitted within the ceremony room.

# Accessibility

There are designated accessible parking bays near the event entrance at Ramside Hall.

The entirety of the graduation event takes place on the ground floor and all areas (including the stage) are accessible via ramps for anyone with mobility difficulties.

If any of your guests have specific requirements (including accessibility) this should be indicated when purchasing guest tickets.

## Dietary requirements

As well as advising us when registering online for graduation, please advise the Food and Beverage Team at the venue (Ramside Hall) on the day, if you or your guests have any dietary or allergen requirements.

## Award Certificates

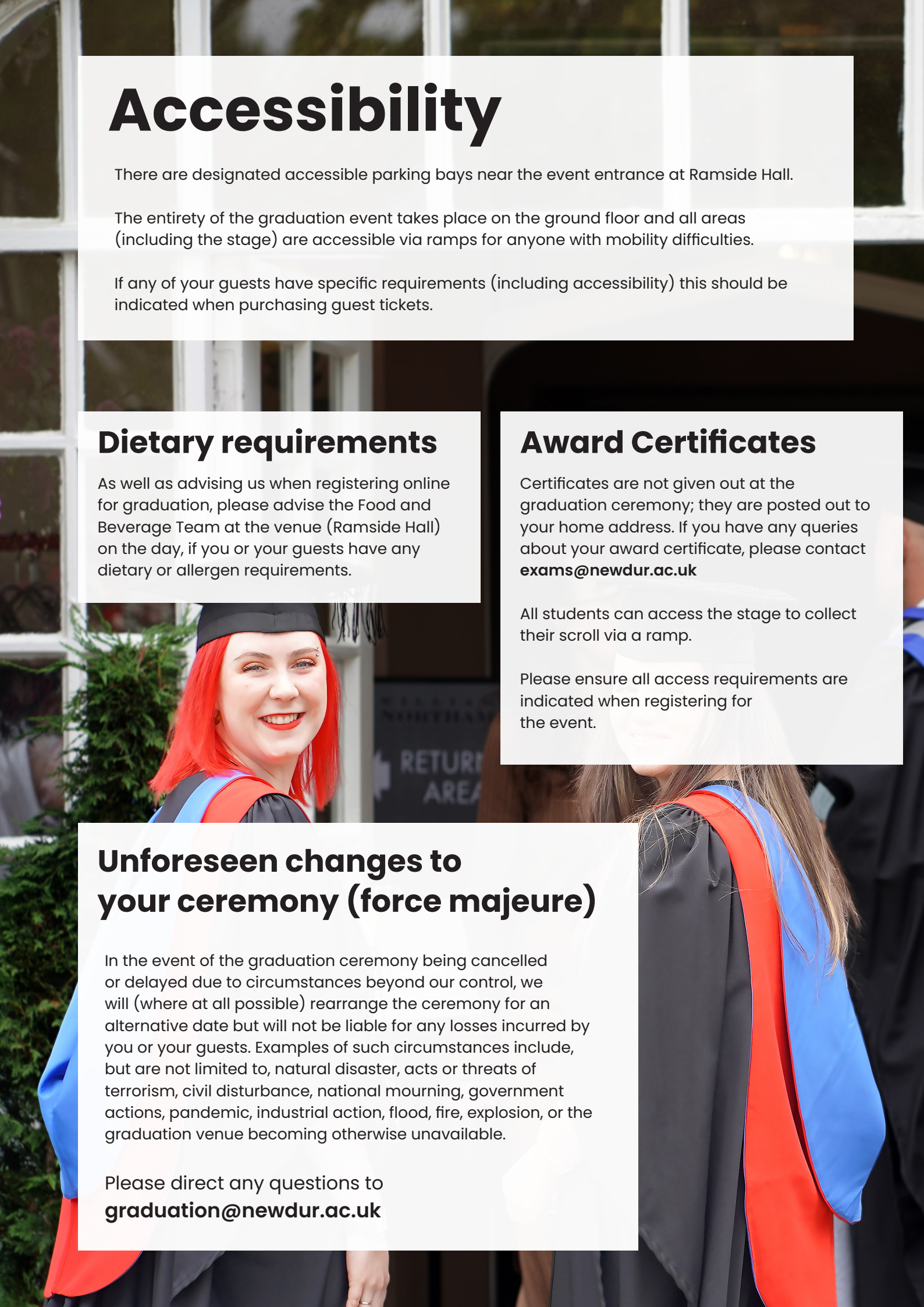
All students can access the stage to collect their scroll via a ramp.

## Unforeseen changes to your ceremony (force majeure)

Examples of such circumstances include, but are not limited to, natural disaster, acts or threats of terrorism, civil disturbance, national mourning, government actions, pandemic, industrial action, flood, fire, explosion, or the graduation venue becoming otherwise unavailable.
